Continuing Reunion Gouge

The 2021 NCVA Reunion in Ft. Worth, Texas, June 16 - 20, 2021 is still ON!!!. Three members of your planning team were in Fort Worth 27-29 April for a final planning meeting with the hotel staff. These meetings went exceptionally well, the manager even called us "rock stars." This hotel will be delighted to see us. We are only the second post-COVID, national-scope "convention" to be held in downtown Fort Worth.

Watch this space! We will continue to bring you the latest news and updates – right up until June 16.

NCVA sponsored tours managed by Military Reunion Planners are all cancelled. The reason: Not enough people signed up to meet the minimum number required. Does this mean you cannot go to the Stockyard area or the museum district area – IT DOES NOT! Uber, taxi, shared rides and the hotel shuttle are some obvious options. Fort Worth offers a lot – a museum district, a botanical garden, Sundance Square, the Stockyards, etc. We are also in the process of planning additional in-hotel activities.

No, as stated in the Spring 2021 Cryptolog, this will not be your grandfather's reunion. Other changes – driven by COVID-reduced numbers or COVID itself – are: cash bar, release of liability waiver for attendees to sign, and a one-day reduction. We currently plan for about 125 attendees, down from the normal 300+. Over 400 attended the Nashville reunion in 2017. Our smaller reunion gives rise to special financial challenges.

Keeping the reunion safe is the paramount consideration. Pease review the "Reunion Gouge" article in the last Cryptolog regarding the release of liability waiver.

The hotel now expects that they can provide a hot buffet breakfast and a banquet with rounds of eight and the BBQ. Our meeting area will be smaller. The hotel will provide a bar in the hospitality room, hours reduced and happy hour prices. The bar will stay open each night as long as it makes money.

Since this is a significant cut-back, **register and reserve your room soonest**. More detailed information will soon be sent to the registered reunion attendees.
