This is the oldest major botanic gardens in Texas, established in 1934 in the heart of the Cultural District. Consists of 109 acres with 23 specialty gardens including the Rose Garden and Japanese Garden. There is also the Rock Springs Cafe should you need a break and refreshments. There are two special exhibits in place, "Nature Connects with Lego Bricks" and "Topiaries in the Garden" - 12 plant based animal shapes. Mule Ally has emerged as the newest destination within the Stockyards - 100 shops - apparel boutiques, artisan, home accessories, souvenirs and lifestyle. Cultural District includes Cowgirl Hall of Fame and the Cowboy Hall of Fame. The Texas Trail of Fame is set in the sidewalks and walkways throughout the Stockyards National Historic District and features 100 bronze inlaid markers honoring men and women and groups who made significant contributions to the Western way of life.
